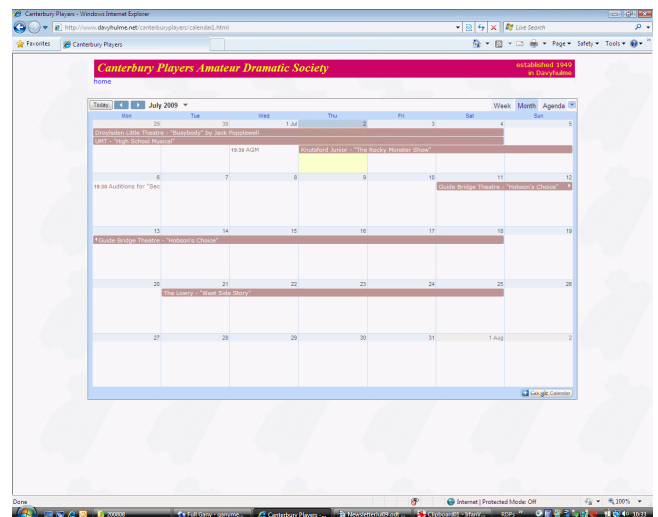
Subscriptions
